
Use the scissors to cut along the lines.



Top tip:

Blue scissors are for children who are right handed. Green and yellow scissors are for children who are left handed.

Can you do all of the buttons up?









Top tips:

Always start at the top.

One hand holds the button, the other hand pulls the hole open. Finally push the button through the hole.

Practise your sound formation in the foam.









Top tips:


Hold the paintbrush in the 'perfect pencil grip'.

Use the formation card to help you form your letters.

Make sure your child starts their sound formation in the correct place.

Write your sounds on the tramlines.





Top tips:

Look at the example to see where the sound should sit.

Remember the perfect posture-both feet on the floor, bottoms on the seat, back up straight, paper in a straight portrait position and you steady hand holds the paper.
