We also recommend **SPELLODROME** (charges apply) which challenges children to spell different words and also gives parents regular updates about the words the child has spelt correctly and incorrectly: <https://uk.spellodrome.com>

Why not also try **THE POST-IT GAME** before listening to your child read? This is a fun way to warm up before reading their book.



How to play: Write at least 10 single words which are appropriate for your child on separate post it notes. Hide these post-it notes around your home. Ask your child to find a word or words using age appropriate clues and questions such as;

- Find a word with the 'ee' sound.
- Find the words with two or more syllables.
- Find two words which have nearly the same or exactly the same meaning (synonyms) e.g. slim & thin, coarse & rough, gift & present).
- You have 3 minutes to find all 10 words and sort them into nouns, verbs and adjectives. Go!

WORKING TOGETHER

At this school we always work together to ensure our pupils are happy and safe. We also work together to ensure families have a voice so their concerns, views and opinions are heard.

In the first instance you can always approach the **Headteacher** (Mr Custance) about any concern or question you may have. You can also request a call back by contacting the Office Team using the details below. Mr Custance will then offer advice and support or he will guide you to the right person for the appropriate advice and support.

You can also raise concerns, views and opinions using the following process:

STEP 1: We always attempt to resolve any issues or concerns at classroom level first. Our **class teachers** are always ready to help.

STEP 2: If Step 1 is not successful then you can request to meet one of the **Assistant Headteachers**; Ms Burke, (Years 2 & 3), Mrs Fry (Year 1) Mrs Davies (Nursery & Reception). Please request a call-back or a meeting by emailing or calling the School Office.

STEP 3: On the very rare occasion that Steps 1 & 2 do not bring a satisfactory conclusion to the issue then a request can be made to meet with Mr Custance (**Headteacher**).

Please talk to your class teacher to find out which badge your child should be aiming for and how the badges are awarded.




The 1+4 Badge
