What has happened in Nursery recently?	What has happened in Reception recently?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nightingale class have been learning about themselves, recognising themselves using mirror and naming facial features. They have been exploring sequences, copying a bear sequences and naming colour. Seacole class have been learning about where fruit and vegetables come from and how they grow. They tasted the blackberries and used adjectives to describe how they tasted. Some children thought they were sweet, and some thought they were sour. They have been learning about John Peake Knight, the man who invented traffic lights and even created some of their own. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reception have continued to be fully immersed in all things Gingerbread, they have created masks, drawn the characters and created playdough Gingerbread men. Excitingly we also made and decorated Gingerbread. As part of our bread topic, Reception have been tasting breads from around the world and practising their spreading skills. We ended this topic by making sandwiches. To celebrate Black History Month, Reception have been learning about different black musicians including Bob Marley and Stevie Wonder as part of their music lessons.
