Welcome to the next addition of the EYFS catch up! These newsletters will give a snap shot of what has been happening in our nursery and Reception classes.

We have come to the end of another successful term, it was lovely to see so many of you to celebrate all the children's hard work at the end of term showcase. On the penultimate day of term all children enjoyed a fantastic mindfulness day, giving them to opportunity to engage in relaxing yoga sessions, create healthy edible rainbows and work together to create mandalas. What has happened in Nursery recently?

What has happened in Reception recently?

- Nursery have enjoyed their gymnastics sessions this term, they have been developing their balancing skills by walking along beams and gaining control over their bodies through a range of large movements.
- Nightingale class have been exploring measure in maths- focussing on the big, small, tall and short. They were challenged to use cubes to find out how tall a giraffe was.
- Seacole class have been colour mixing, exploring primary and secondary colours. The children used jugs and pipettes to mix the colours together. In maths, the children have been continuing and creating AB and ABC patterns.
- As part of their wider curriculum lessons, Reception have been exploring observational drawings of animals. They used a range of media to first draw their chosen animals and then create a background. This work was inspired by the artist Henri Rosseau.
- In Literacy, children have been learning the story 'The Wonder', they then wrote sentences thinking about things they might wonder about such as I wonder what snails taste like.
 - In maths, children have been developing their doubling skills. Children are now confidently recalling doubles up to 5+5.
