

WORKING TOGETHER

At this school we always work together to ensure our pupils are happy and safe. We also work together to ensure families have a voice so their concerns, views and opinions are heard.

In the first instance you can always approach the **Headteacher** (Mr Custance) about any concern or question you may have. Mr Custance will then offer advice and support or he will guide you to the right person for the appropriate advice and support.

You can also raise concerns, views and opinions using the following process:

STEP 1: We always attempt to resolve any issues or concerns at classroom level first. Our **class teachers** are always ready to help.

STEP 2: If Step 1 is not successful then you can request to meet one of the **Leaders** (either one of the Key Stage Leaders or one of the Assistant Headteachers).


STEP 3: On the very rare occasion that Steps 1 & 2 do not bring a satisfactory conclusion to the issue then a request can be made to meet with Mr Custance (**Headteacher**).

We must urge all families to make sure that pupils are through the green gate on Farlton Rd by **8.37am at the very latest.**


It is very important that pupils begin lessons on time so that they do not miss out on any key learning.

- And achieving architecture mastery in Reception!




