
SENSATIONAL SCIENCE!

Year 5 experienced a workshop led by a scientist who guided them on how to make a solar-powered oven, and taught them new things such as how black absorbs heat, how tin foil refracts light, which creates more heat and that plastic reflection creates the greenhouse effect. During this session, we learnt about lots of gasses; carbon dioxide, water vapour and oxygen. After this session, we then created our own set of instructions entitled 'How to make a Solar Powered Oven.' 
TEAM BONDING TIME!

Pupils from Years 3, 4 & 5 took part in a House Playtime and their challenge was to leave school with one or more new friend from another year group!




SCI-FI STORY WRITING
