# Welcome to our Nursery

Floreat Wandsworth Nursery is a vital part of our school. It is situated in its own section of the school building and has direct access to a large EYFS playground that is shared with Reception. The children have access to two further playgrounds, one of which has a large climbing frame and trim-trail. Our approach to learning is centred around the child, our staff have the experience and knowledge to close the gaps and get the best from our youngest learners.

During the school day, the children enjoy a wide range of activities including, carpet time, group time and time to follow their own interests. The children are able to access the rest of the school's resources including Character, Spanish, PE and dance lessons. We are also excited to announce that the children will take part in a 10-week Forest School programme during the Spring and Summer terms. The education is assessed against the EYFS curriculum.

# A Typical Day

Every day your child will enjoy a broad range of different subjects and learning experiences. We follow a similar timetable every day, so that we can embed our classroom routines and master skills that are important within subjects, such as English and Maths.

<b>11.30 - 12.30pm</b>	Lunch/Break Time
<b>12.30 - 1.00pm</b>	Maths or English
<b>1.00 - 3.00pm</b>	Choosing Time
<b>2.00 - 2.15pm</b>	Knowledge/Character or Jigsaw
<b>2.15 - 3.00pm</b>	Choosing
<b>3.00 - 3.30pm</b>	Reflection and Milk Time

# Food

We have a family style approach to eating at our Floreat Wandsworth Nursery. We encourage exploration, enjoyment and healthy discussions around the topic of food.

- At snack time we offer a piece of fruit or a vegetable and we always discuss the name of item, how it grows, colour and taste
- We have free milk available to all Nursery children through the Cool Milk scheme (please complete link in starter pack)
- We provide labelled water cups for all children

# Trips and Visitors

Throughout the year we welcome visitors into Nursery and provide opportunities to go on trips.

- Visitors to our Nursery include Earlsfield community police offices, our local school nurse, traffic safety officers, dentists and we have parents coming in to read to us weekly.
- We really enjoy being part of our community. We love taking local trips across to King George's Park, Earlsfield library and the local shops. In the Summer Term we take a coach to Bocketts Farm to visit the animals.
- We are a valued part of the school and we will join in with the Christmas Nativity, have a end of year performance and we are welcomed to events where outside agencies come in and talk to us.

# Communicating with Parents

Good working relationships are really important to us. We foster these by:

- Having an 'open door' policy
- Hosting a minimum of three Family Learning Events across the year
- Having three Parent Evening sessions across the year
- Class WhatsApp groups

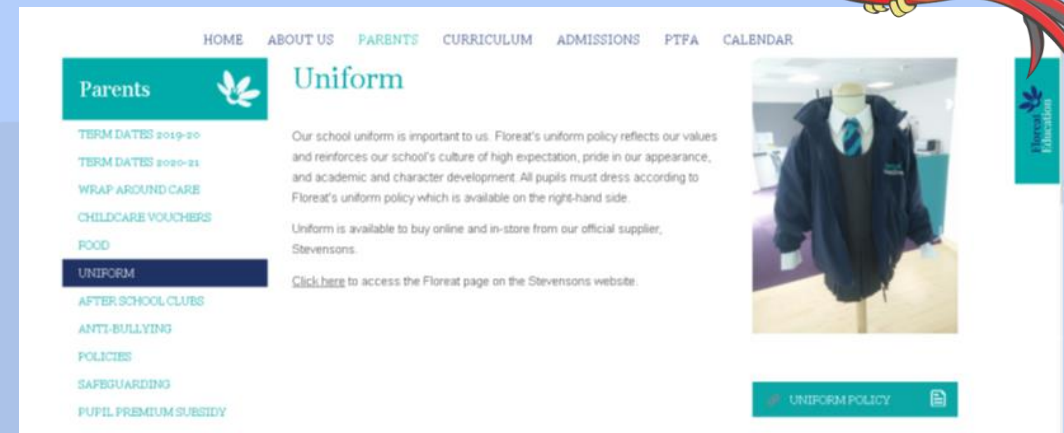
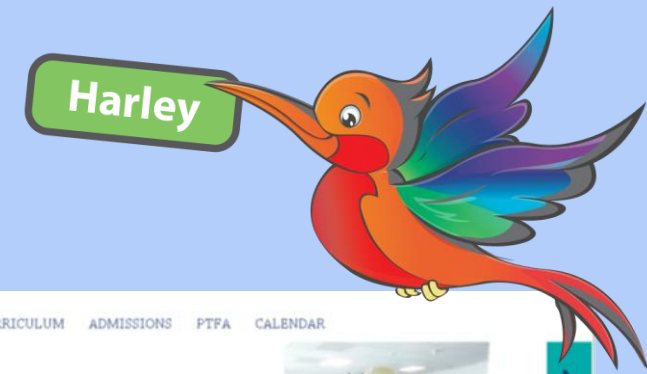

<b>Additional hours</b>	Wednesday top up - 11.00am - 3.30pm or 8.30-1.00pm Daily 30 minute top up (to start the day at 8.30)
<b>School hot lunch</b>	School lunch not included, please choose to bring a healthy packed lunch or pay for a school hot lunch
