- Pupils will return on Wednesday and attend school on Thursday and Friday.


### Why PGL?

- Leadership, teamwork, communication and problem solving are all key skills that pupils will develop and make progress with on a PGL multiactivity course.
- Overcoming new challenges with the support of their peers, teachers and PGL staff helps to develop character, resilience, self-confidence and independence.
- The outdoors environment provides many opportunities for pupils to work closely together and will help improve their social awareness.
- Reaching goals as a team means pupils are able to recognise the achievements of others as well as their own.
- Development of many personal qualities such as self-reliance, responsibility, initiative and perseverance.













#### How much will it be?

- The trip, including transport, accommodation and all actives will be £350 per child.
- PGL Camp will be added to ParentPay and you can pay in instalments or as you wish. Full payment will be required by March 25<sup>th</sup>.
- If your child receives Pupil Premium funding, the school will contribute £100 towards the trip which will be reflected in your Parent Pay.
